On behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon), Environmental Resources Management (ERM) is submitting this request for extension of the Tier IB Permit (No. 133939) for the Former Raytheon Facility (the "Site") located at 430 Boston Post Road in Wayland, Massachusetts. Please find enclosed the following documents:

- A copy of the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Permit Transmittal Form (Transmittal Ref. No. W055508) (Appendix A)
- BWSC-20 Tier I Permit Extension Application- the original (clipped to front) and one copy (Appendix B)
- A copy of the Permit Application Fee submittal sent to MA DEP, P.O. Box 4062, Boston, MA 02211 (Appendix A)
- Additional supporting documentation (copies of public notice letters, affidavit of legal notice, and copy of notice) (Appendix C).

Pursuant to 310 CMR 40.0706, the following information is included to support this request:

Statement as to why the Permit Extension is sought.

This Permit Extension is sought to continue the transition from Phase IV to Phase V activities at the Site. Extension of the permit will enable Phase

V activities to proceed without interruption for the purpose of achieving a Response Action Outcome (RAO).

Phase IV remedial actions (i.e., groundwater remediation utilizing chemical oxidation and excavation and restoration of impacted wetland soil/sediment) were recently completed. A Draft Phase IV Completion Report was distributed to the Public Involvement Plan (PIP) group on 6 October 2004. Following receipt of PIP comments, a Final Phase IV Completion Report will be submitted to the DEP in November 2004. Also, an Immediate Response Action Completion (IRAC) statement for assessment of wetland soil/sediment was submitted to the DEP on 9 September 2004.

A schedule to complete additional work at the facility is presented below.


Phase V monitoring and sampling activities are currently being initiated at the Site to move towards closure. Phase V activities include:

Pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.0703), an application for a Permit Extension is being submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for this site on October 15, 2004. DEP issued a Tier I permit for the site in November 1997. The application proposes to extend the permit for the site to November 28, 2006 for the following rationale:

- To continue the transition from Phase IV to Phase V activities at the site. Extension of the permit will enable Phase V activities to proceed without interruption for the purpose of achieving a Response Action Outcome (RAO).

Once a site has been classified as Tier I, a permit is required to proceed with a Comprehensive Remedial Response Process. Anyone interested in reviewing the Permit Extension application should notify DEP by writing to DEP Northeast Region File Facility located in the Department of Transitional Assistance Building, 35 Congress Street, Shetland Office Park, Salem, MA 01970. If anyone notifies DEP of his or her interest in reviewing or submitting comment on the application, DEP will conduct a public comment review period of twenty (20) days which shall run concurrently with DEP's Initial Technical Review of the application. Anyone who fails to notify DEP in writing of his/her interest in commenting on the application by November 11, 2004 may be deemed to have waived his/her rights, if any, to appeal DEP's permit decision or to intervene in an adjudicatory proceeding with respect to this application, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.0770(2).

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of, and involvement in, decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.
