

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Environmental Resources Management (ERM), on behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon) has developed a document incorporating responses to all public comments regarding the Phase II and Phase III Reports for the Site entitled, "*Response to Public Comments on Phase II and III Reports, Former Raytheon Facility Site, 430 Boston Post Road, Wayland, Massachusetts.*" Copies of this document are available for your review and are located in the public repositories at the Wayland Public Library and the Wayland Board of Health Office.
