On behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon), Environmental Resources Management (ERM) is submitting an Immediate Response Action (IRA) Six-Month Status Report for the Site. This submittal was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP), 310 CMR 40.0000. This report represents the sixth status report for the IRA.

#### **BACKGROUND**

In accordance with the requirements of the MCP, 310 CMR 40.0480, ERM submitted a Phase I-Initial Site Investigation (Phase I) report for the Site to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) in July 1996 and a Tier Classification filing in January 1997. The DEP issued Raytheon a Tier IB Permit, effective 21 May 1997. The Phase II-Comprehensive Site Assessment (Phase II) and Phase III Remedial Action Plan (Phase III) reports were submitted to the DEP on 28 November 2001. The Phase IV Remedy Implementation Plan (Phase IV) was submitted to the DEP on 30 December 2002.

Results of the Phase II linked a suspected area of stunted growth to elevated levels of metals, polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs). The reduced stem count of biota in this area indicated that a potential imminent hazard may exist,

based on the criteria set forth in 310 CMR 40.0955(3). The potential Imminent Hazard Condition was reported to the DEP on 26 April 2000.

An IRA Plan was submitted to the DEP on 26 June 2000 following the imminent hazard determination. The Imminent Hazard Evaluation determined that the Site did not pose an Imminent Hazard to human health or safety, but posed a potential Imminent Hazard to the environment. The objective of the IRA Plan is to continue to assess Site conditions according to the Phase II Scope of Work and addendum in the wetlands, to delineate the extent of impact to sediments and surface water, and assess risk to human health and the environment.

Pursuant to 310 CMR 40.0530, a Major Permit Modification Application was filed on 25 May 2000 to upgrade the Site tier classification and permit from Tier IB to Tier IA following the re-evaluation of the Site Numerical Ranking Score (NRS). On 7 September 2000, Raytheon received a Notice of Proposed Permit Decision from the DEP, which indicated that a new Tier IB permit would be issued with special conditions. Tier IB Permit number 133939 was issued on October 30, 2000.

#### STATUS OF ASSESSMENT

Assessment activities have been completed at the Site and were documented in the Phase II and Phase IV reports. Comprehensive response actions are currently being implemented in accordance with the Phase IV.

#### **NEW SITE INFORMATION**

The selected remedial alternative is to excavate impacted wetland soil/sediment, transport excavated material off-Site for disposal, and restore the wetland. The following permit applications to complete this work were submitted to federal, state and local agencies:

 Risk-Based Disposal Approval Application – PCB remediation and disposal permit required by the Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) under the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). DEP 10686 27 October 2003 Page 3

- Army Corps of Engineers Section 404 Review Permit Application— Department of the Army requires a permit for disturbance of a wetland that is greater then one acre.
- Massachusetts Environmental Protection Act (MEPA) Remediation projects in a wetland resource area are required to obtain MEPA approval through review of the project by multiple state agencies.
- 401 Water Quality Certification A determination of impact to a river or floodplain by an excavation project.
- Notice of Intent Order of Conditions from Wayland Conservation Commission.

These permit applications have been approved and wetlands sediment remedial activities were initiated at the Site on 29 September 2003. It is expected that that the wetlands remediation project will be completed in December 2003 with ongoing monitoring activities for an additional five years. Figure 1 depicts the Site Remediation Layout.

#### MANAGEMENT OF REMEDIAL WASTE

No remediation waste has been generated on-Site in the last six months. During the wetland remediation project, approximately 4,200 cubic yards of impacted sediments will be shipped off-Site for disposal. Generation and off-Site disposal of material will be documented in the next status report. Water pumped from the excavation, to conduct verification sampling, will be either transported off-Site or discharged to the Sudbury River via an National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Emergency Exclusion Permit.

#### REMEDIAL SYSTEMS DATA

No remedial systems are currently operated on-Site.

Ongoing monitoring of an in-situ chemical oxidation pilot study is being conducted as part of a Release Abatement Measure (RAM).

#### OTHER INFORMATION

The installed fence along the wetland boundary at the Site is regularly inspected and appears in good condition.

#### LSP OPINION

It is the opinion of the LSP that this IRA is being conducted in conformance with the IRA Plan. The IRA Transmittal Form (BWSC-105) is included in Appendix A.




