## NOTICE OF A PHASE IV COMPLETION REPORT

## FORMER RAYTHEON FACILITY 430 BOSTON POST ROAD, WAYLAND, MASSACHUSETTS RELEASE TRACKING NUMBER: 3-13302 TIER IB PERMIT #133939

A Phase IV Completion Report containing the elements required for an As-Built Construction Report, Final Inspection Report, and Phase IV Completion Statement in accordance with 310 CMR 40.0875, 40.0878, and 40.0879, respectively, was developed and submitted to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for the above site pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40.0000). DEP issued a Tier I Permit for the site in November 1997. A Tier IB Permit Extension was submitted to the DEP on 15 October 2004.

The Phase IV Completion Report presents two distinct remediation efforts to respond to a release of oil and/or hazardous material at the site:

- ♦ Implementation of in-situ chemical oxidation to reduce concentrations of volatile organic compounds in groundwater.
- Excavation and remediation of wetlands soil/sediment to reduce concentrations of polychlorinated biphenyls, polyaromatic hydrocarbons, and metals.

M.G.L. c. 21E and the Massachusetts Contingency Plan provide additional opportunities for public notice of and involvement in decisions regarding response actions at disposal sites: 1) The Chief Municipal Official and Board of Health of the community in which the site is located will be notified of major milestones and events, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1403; and 2) Upon receipt of a petition from ten or more residents of the municipality in which the disposal site is located, or of a municipality potentially affected by a disposal site, a plan for involving the public in decisions regarding response actions at the site will be prepared and implemented, pursuant to 310 CMR 40.1405.

Raytheon has implemented the Public Involvement Process in accordance with MCP requirements for the site.
