Raytheon Company is pleased to be working closely with you and the Wayland community concerning the environmental issues at our Wayland Site. Raytheon is committed to working through the public involvement plan (PIP) process to continue to expand on this cooperative relationship. We value your input and agree that once the Site is Tier Classified, the PIP should be modified to incorporate the new Release Tracking Number (RTN) for the "northern portion" of the Site.

We appreciate your time in coordinating the PIP petition and volunteering to discuss with us on how Raytheon can improve the Site PIP plan. I recommend that we discuss this further after the holidays and schedule a meeting to discuss amending the Site PIP. Raytheon will then incorporate those recommendations into an Amended PIP and allow the general Wayland community to comment on the document.

Raytheon also shares your concerns regarding protection of groundwater within the Wayland community. Let me state, we are committed to assessing and cleaning up the Site to ensure that a level of no significant risk to public safety, health and the environment is achieved.

Thank you for providing comments on our ongoing response actions at the Wayland Site. I look forward to working with you in the upcoming PIP process.
