RE: Request for Work Approval, DEP File No. 322-0564, 430 Boston  
Post Road, Former Raytheon Facility

Dear Mr. Calichman:

Environmental Resources Management (ERM), on behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon), submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) on 26 September 2003 to the Town of Wayland Conservation Commission to conduct environmental assessment activities pursuant to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP, 310 CMR 40.0000) at the former Raytheon Facility at 430 Boston Post Road in Wayland, Massachusetts. The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) assigned File Number 322-0564 for this NOI.

In the NOI, ERM proposed to advance three soil borings and install three well triplets within the Wetland Resource Area of the Sudbury River (Figure 1) as part of field investigation activities. These wells will be used exclusively for groundwater sampling to further delineate the extent of chlorinated volatile compound (CVOC) impacts being tracked under DEP Release Tracking Number 3-22408.

These activities were approved and will be conducted in accordance with the Town of Wayland Conservation Commission Order of Conditions and Wetlands and Water Resources Permit (Chapter 194), dated 20 November 2003. The following Condition, included in the Order, relates to the Town of Wayland Board of Health:

Condition 33 states:

*"Prior to commencing any work at the site the applicant shall submit to the Commission evidence that the Wayland Board of Health has reviewed the wells and issued an approval or deemed such approval unnecessary."*



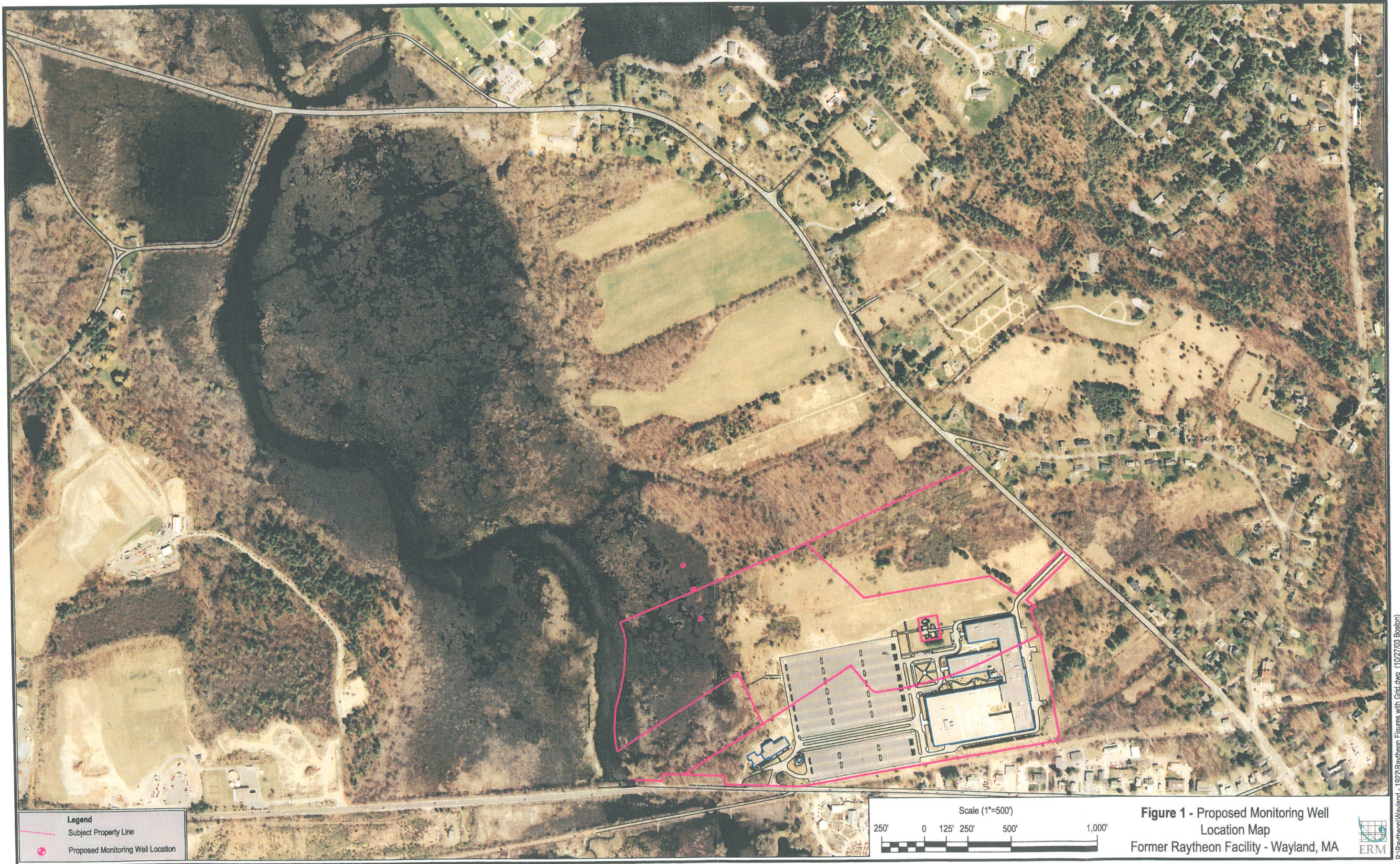
