Raytheon Company (Raytheon) has prepared this letter in response to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP)'s request for completion of the 2007 United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Hazardous Waste Report (Biennial Report) and the Massachusetts Notification of Hazardous Activity in Massachusetts Form. The hazardous waste generator's number at the former Raytheon facility in Wayland, Massachusetts is MAC 300008828.

Raytheon will not be submitting a Biennial Report to the EPA as they did not generate over 2,200 pounds of RCRA Waste or 2.2 pounds of acute RCRA waste in any calendar month during 2007. There was no hazardous waste generated at this site or under this number in 2007.

The facility wishes to change its Large Quantity Generator (LQG) status to Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) status. A Notification of Hazardous Activity in Massachusetts Form is attached to update Raytheon's status at this Site.
