Dear Ms. Leary:

I have received your letter and accompanying Notice of Change (NOC) form dated September 11, 2007, regarding a NOC request for the groundwater remediation system operating at the site noted above.

The NOC you have requested is for the "Change of Discharge Location" from the originally proposed site which was the storm water drainage system which ultimately discharges to the wetland adjacent to the Sudbury River to the Sudbury River directly using a one (1) inch PVC hose. EPA allows for a change of the discharge location within the same receiving stream provided the permittee and operator of the treatment system meets the tradability requirements set in the RGP's Authorization letter for this site issued October 3, 2006.

This NOC does not constitute permission or authorization to trespass the wetland and or terrain needed to lay down the PVC hose. It is the responsibility of the operator to obtain permission from the proper State authorities managing this type of activities.

Please note a direct discharge to the receiving stream affords a reduction on the metal concentrations only and does not reduce the concentration of all other pollutants (volatile organics, etc) required to be treated at this site. The request is acceptable and therefore the treated dewatering effluent may be discharged to the Sudbury River directly effective immediately. The discharge from the remediation system may continue in accordance with all other provisions of the RGP and the authorization letter.
