

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

On April 7, 2005 at 9:00 p.m. in the Town Office Building, 41 Cochituate Road, the Conservation Commission will hold a Public Meeting pursuant to Wayland Wetlands and Water Resources Bylaw, Chapter 194 to consider an application filed by Edwin Madera/Raytheon Company, 528 Boston Post Road, Sudbury, MA 01776. The applicant is proposing site investigation activities related to the former Raytheon Facility in Wayland, MA on Boston Post Road. The investigations are proposed within 100 feet of wetlands and are intended to further characterize impacts to groundwater as part of response actions under the Massachusetts Contingency Plan. The property is at 400 Boston Post Road, shown on Assessor's Map 23, Parcels 52C and 52D.



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This is an **ABUTTER'S NOTICE** to inform you that a property listed below, within 100' of your property, has filed an application with the Conservation Commission. The application is filed since the activity is within 100 feet of wetlands, a water body, or land subject to flooding and inundation or within 200 feet of a perennial stream.
