On behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon), Environmental Resources Management (ERM) prepared this letter to inform members of the Public Involvement Plan (PIP) group that a PIP meeting will not be scheduled in fall/winter 2006. We believe that a PIP meeting at this time is not necessary since the remedial activities proposed in the Final Phase IV Remedy Implementation Plan (RIP), dated 17 August 2006, have been delayed until 2007.

At the request of the Town, Raytheon has agreed to participate in an informational session to discuss Site status. The meeting will be held at 7:30 pm on 15 November 2006 in the Large Hearing Room at the Wayland Town Hall. All interested parties are encouraged to attend.




