Raytheon Company (Raytheon) submitted a Risk Based Disposal Approval Application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on December 23, 2002 seeking approval for the remedial goals, proposed area of excavation and restoration plan for the wetlands portion of the Site. Raytheon proposes to excavate and restore approximately 1.8 acres of impacted wetland at the Site. As part of this process, Raytheon responded to several EPA comments and submitted a Revised Risk Based Disposal Approval Application on July 2003 to the EPA. In accordance with the EPA process, public comments on the EPA Draft Approval Letter are due to the EPA by October 1, 2003. Please forward any comments to the following:



DRAFT PCB CLEANUP AND DISPOSAL APPROVAL

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region I (EPA) is hereby providing public notice of EPA's proposed approval of the request by Raytheon Company (Raytheon) to clean up and dispose of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) at the former Raytheon facility located at 430 Boston Post Road, Wayland, Massachusetts. The proposed approval would be issued under Section 6(e)(1) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) and the federal PCB regulations at 40 CFR Part 761. Clean up of non-PCB contaminants at the facility is being addressed under the Massachusetts Contingency Plan 310 CMR 40.0000.

The purpose of this public notice is to solicit written comments concerning the proposed approval. Raytheon's Application for approval (in the form of a risk-based disposal application), Raytheon's supporting documentation for the cleanup, and the proposed approval are available for public inspection at the following locations during normal business hours:
