C. Project Description

1b. Area Description

The Site is an approximately 83-acre property located at 430 Boston Post Road in Wayland, Massachusetts (Figure 1). The Site is comprised of a main complex of eight attached buildings, one exterior building and a series of sheds and outbuildings (Figure 2). The Site also includes approximately 32 acres of either wetlands of wetland buffer zones and 41 acres of undeveloped grass and woodlands.

The Site is bounded to the west by the Sudbury River and the Great Meadows National Wildlife Refuge (GMNWR), to the north by the GMNWR and undeveloped property, to the east by Route 27 and to the south by Route 20. Portions of the Site are zoned for residential and limited commercial uses.

The proposed removal of fencing at the Site will be limited to the wetland buffer zone and will not include any fill or dredging or construction of additional structures.

2a. Work Description

To meet the requirements of the Tier 1B Permit No. 133939 issued 7 September 2000, ERM and Raytheon installed a chain link fence and signage in November 2001 to limit access to the wetland while a condition of Imminent Hazard, as defined under 310 CMR 40.0955, existed. These activities were conducted by ERM and approved of the Town of Wayland Conservation Commission under Determination of Applicability D-503.


Comprehensive response actions conducted under MA DEP #322-553 in the wetland are complete. Minor restoration activities and off-site disposal of staged soils will be completed in the coming months. Remediation and restoration activities have mitigated the risk to human health and the environment; therefore the fence and signage is no longer required under Tier 1B Permit No. 133939.


ERM and Raytheon propose to remove the fence and signage. The chain link fence will be dismantled by hand without the use of heavy equipment. Any holes or depressions created during removal of the fence posts will be filled with

clean topsoil. The snow fence installed to the limit of bordering vegetated wetland will by removed by hand.

It is ERM's opinion that the proposed activities are considered exempt pursuant to 310 CMR 10.58(6)(b)(2) as the activities will remove a temporary fence placed under an exemption of this same regulation. ERM will conduct the proposed work activities using measures that minimize alterations to the existing natural resources.
