

Draft Public Involvement Plan Former Raytheon Facility 430 Boston Post Road Wayland, Massachusetts



On behalf of Raytheon Company (Raytheon), Environmental Resources Management (ERM) is pleased to present this response summary to the draft Public Involvement Plan (PIP), submitted 23 August 2000. A public meeting was held to discuss the draft PIP on 28 September 2000.

The following is a summary of written comments Raytheon received and their response to each comment:

From Linda Segal, letter dated 20 September:

 Please do not send me correspondence via certified mail unless absolutely necessary. My husband and I prefer to receive these mailings via regular first class mail. That will save you the expense and us the hassle of going to the post office to retrieve it.

All mail will be sent return receipt instead of certified mail to all PIP mailing list participants

 On the same PIP mailing list I offer the following two spelling corrections: Mr. Karl Nowak (not Howak), and the Wastewater Management Committee chairman is Mr. Gene Roberts (not Ms. Joan Roberts)





Corrections will be made in the PIP

• In the Draft PIP Plan, page 3, paragraph 2. 1. 1, second paragraph: portions of the site are zoned <u>for Residential and Limited</u> <u>Commercial</u> uses (suggested editing underlined).

Corrections will be made in the PIP

 In the Draft PIP Plan, page 13: 1 assume this section will be revised to include the latest information available from DEP about the status of this permit modification (i.e. Tier 1 B with Special Conditions).

The information regarding Tier IB permit will be inserted as available.

• In the Draft PIP Plan, page 14, paragraph 2.3: Reference is made to the Exhibit 1 list of attendees at the August 22 meeting held in Wayland Town Building. Missing from that list is attendee and participant Steven Calichman, Wayland Health Director.

Mr. Calichman's name will be added to the listed.

• In the Draft PIP Plan, pages 20 & 21, 1 offer the following corrections: The phone number for Jeff Ritter is 508 358 3620, for Steven Calichman it is 508 358 3616, and my phone numbers are listed on this letterhead. The best number during the workday to leave me phone mail messages is 781 895 1444.

The phone numbers will be updated as indicated.

• In the Draft PIP Plan, page 21, paragraph 4.2.5: Is this a brand new AUL filing or a clarification of the older/original AUL?

The text will be clarified. The intent of the text is to describe what actions will be taken if a new AUL is instituted on site.

• In the Draft PIP Plan, page 22, paragraph 4.3.1: It seems important and appropriate to hold a public meeting upon the completion of the Phase 2 investigation, including the results of the risk assessment.

meeting will be held following the completion Phase II Comprehensive Site Assessment.

• In the Draft PIP Plan, page 23, paragraph 4.3.2: If there is to be a public meeting for explaining the Phase 2 investigation and risk assessment products, it seems logical to add the Phase 2 Report to the documents available for public comment.

See answer to above.

• Exhibit 1, page 1: Please correct spelling of Gene Roberts on the mailing list.

The mailing list will be updated accordingly.

• Figures: It would probably help the lay reader who consults this document at the repository if there is a figure (site plan) with more detailed information marked on it, i.e. location of areas of greatest environmental concern; identification of certain locations such as the wastewater treatment plant, proposed day care facility, labeling of Routes 20 and 27, etc.

The figure will be updated to add road labels. A more complete figure will be available upon the completion of the Phase II site investigation.
