Wayland, MA - Northern Area Investigation

- Evaluate potential for VOCs in Northern Area – 2003 - 2004
 - Used an "innovative technology" to advance 15 Waterloo Vertical Profiler locations
 - Temporary groundwater points
 - 123 groundwater samples analyzed for VOCs
- Data collected by DEP and Waterloo Vertical Profiler suggest impact to Baldwin Pond Wellfield is unlikely
- Additional source characterization
- Three monitoring well clusters in wetland in 2005



Wayland, MA - Southern Area Remediation

- Permanganate Pilot Conducted 2001/2002
- Proceeded with full scale in July 2004
 - Injected 45,600 pounds of Permanganate (10% solution)
 - Inside & Outside of Bldg.
 - Moderate to High pressure injections
- Monitor groundwater concentrations and evaluate overtime



Wayland, MA - Wetland Area Remediation



June 2004

- Planted approximately 71,000 plants as part of restoration
- Transitioned to 5 year monitoring phase

- Excavated 2 acres of wetland soil 2003 – 2004
- Transported approximately 8,000 cubic yards of impacted wetland soil off Site

Wayland Public Involvement Plan

• Purpose of Public Involvement Plan (PIP) Process

- Provide a forum where the public can provide input on response actions at the Site
- Citizens became formally involved in the planning of response actions by submitting a petition (10 Signatures needed)

Raytheon Wayland Site PIP "Plan"

- Original PIP Plan developed in 2000
- Revised PIP Plan developed in 2004

Raytheon Wayland Public Involvement Plan (cont.)

- Public Comment Period on draft documents
 - 30-days following submission of document
- Response to Comments
 - A summary of the comments received and a response to those comments must be prepared within 30-days
- Public meetings
 - During major milestones
- Public Repository
 - Documents are made available at information repositories (the Town Public Library, Board of Health and Site Web page)
- Notification Letters
 - Notice of availability of documents and public meeting is sent to the PIP mailing list

- Memorandum of Understanding 2002
 - Raytheon provides funding for technical expert
- Technical expert
 - assists in educating public
 - independent review of documents
 - provide comment through PIP process




