The purpose of this meeting was for representatives of stakeholder Town of Wayland departments to work directly with Benson Gould, newly hired by the Wayland Board of Selectmen as a consultant for the Town, in preparation for filing written public comment on the May 17, 2002 Draft Scope of Work (SOW) for the Former Raytheon Site, 430 Boston Post Road, Wayland, MA pursuant to DEP's PIP regulations. Mr. Gould also reviewed with us additional comments and questions he had as a new technical expert participating in this long-term cleanup project.

The technical discussion essentially mirrored ERM's draft SOW document and included the following topics:

- definition of background

- testing for COCs (contaminants of concern) in various areas

- clearer citations of specific methods of testing

- respond to DEP's groundwater testing

- address depths of testing, bedrock & deeper

- project needs to generate more information for this Phase 2

- permitting at Conservation Commission

- evaluate COCs in wetland to know what to look for north of site

- minimize invasive testing in wetland, not overly disturb wetland

- impacts to Sudbury River

- what information still seems to be missing, additional testing

- overall project schedule, process and sequencing

- depth profiling still needed

- need TCLP on soils

- PCBs widespread, cleanup standard (1.5 ppm versus 1.8), AUL

- timely to amend PIP plan to improve communication for all parties

- efficient use of consultant's time, level of field involvement
